Voter information may not be used for commercial purposes by state law. KSA 25-2320, 25-2320a

An Open Records Form must be signed to review or purchase any public records information.

Before inspection of any advance voting list, the person must provide identification and sign an application form. KSA 25-1122(e)

General Information

What items are available for purchase?

The Election Office has Voter Data, Advance Voting Data and Maps available for public purchase.

How can I place an order?

Orders may be placed in person at the Election Office, over the telephone, or via e-mail.

When will my order be available?

You orders are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

How can I receive my order?

The Election Office will call when an order(s) is ready for pick up.

When is payment for the order due?

Payment is due when the order is picked up at the Election Office. Orders that are not retrieved in 30 days must be pre-paid in the future.

What methods of payment are accepted?

We accept cash or check for orders.

Using the Information

How could I use the information available?

- * Sort street addresses to create a precinct walking list.
- * Sort to find all Democrats, Republicans, or other party members to create a call list.
- * Find voter history to see who has voted in different elections in the past.
- * Create a mailing list by district, party, or a combination of variables.

How can I get mailing labels?

Take your purchased CD to an outside source to create labels. View bulletin board located in the Election Office Library for information on outside sources.

What type of operating system and/or software is needed to run a CD?

- * A current version of Windows is recommended.
- * A database program like Microsoft Access works well.
- * Basic computer and database knowledge with the ability to import or export data and write queries and reports is beneficial.

Standard Information on CD and E-Mail:

Same data as what is on the Voter Data CD

Advance Voting Data via E-Mail:

- * 20 Day Package - The first day of information is available only on CD, but then all following days are sent via e-mail; or
- * Daily - You may request advance information on a daily basis.

First Day Information:

The First Day information includes the Sick or Disabled voters who are on a list to permanently receive their ballots by mail. This also includes anyone who has applied to receive a ballot by mail for a specific election more than 20 days prior to the election.
