Ballot Questions

City of Olathe - Question #1 Shall the following be adopted? “Shall Charter Ordinance No. 60, entitled ‘A Charter Ordinance exempting the City of Olathe, Kansas from K.S.A. 13-1024a relating to the borrowing of money and the issuance of bonds for general improvements and providing substitute and additional provisions on the same subject; further repealing Charter Ordinances No. 58 and 59;’ take effect pursuant to Article 12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution?”

City of Olathe - Question #2 Shall the following be adopted? “Shall Charter Ordinance No. 61, entitled ‘A Charter Ordinance amending Section 2.1 of Article II of Charter Ordinance No. 28 by increasing the term of office for the Mayor and district Councilmembers from two to four years and providing for the staggering of terms,’ take effect pursuant to Article 12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution?”

City of Olathe - Question #3 Shall the following be adopted? “Shall Charter Ordinance No. 62, entitled ‘A Charter Ordinance amending sections 2.2, 2.7, 2.8 and 2.9 of Charter Ordinance No. 28 by correcting and modifying certain archaic words; amending Section 2.6 by providing substitute and additional procedures to fill Councilmember vacancies; and amending Sections 2.3 and 3.3 to clarify the appointment of the Municipal Judge by the City Council; further repealing existing sections and Charter Ordinance No. 41,’ take effect pursuant to Article 12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution?”

City of Roeland Park Shall the following be adopted? “Shall the City of Roeland Park, Kansas, be authorized to levy a one-fourth of one percent (.25%) city retailers' sales tax, in addition to the one percent (1.0%) tax currently levied, within the City of Roeland Park, Kansas, and to use the revenue from the additional tax for public infrastructure projects including buildings, such additional tax to take effect on April 1, 2003, and to end on March 31, 2013?”

De Soto Unified School District No. 232 Shall the following be adopted? Shall Unified School District No. 232 (De Soto), Johnson County, Kansas, issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$76,750,000 for the purpose of purchasing and improving sites and acquiring, constructing, equipping, furnishing, repairing, remodeling or making additions to buildings used for school district purposes including without limitation (a) constructing, furnishing and equipping new elementary schools, a new middle school, athletic fields and other school facilities, (b) constructing, furnishing and equipping additions to Monticello Trails Middle School, Mill Valley High School and other school facilities, (c) furnishing, equipping and improving existing school facilities, (d) providing new and upgraded computer and communication technology, (e) acquiring sites for school facilities, (f) providing all necessary and related improvements and (g) paying fees and expenses incidental thereto including interest during construction, all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.*, K.S.A. 25-2018(f), K.S.A. 75-2315 *et seq.* and K.S.A. 72-6761?
