

# Student Election Worker Application

There are a limited number of student election worker positions. A student election worker can only be a 16 or 17 year old. Anyone 18 and older must be a registered voter. A recommendation letter from a teacher, counselor, or administrator must accompany each application. (K.S.A. 25-2804) The Election Office will notify students who have been placed at a polling place with an email about their assignment.

## Student Election Worker Information

***I understand that in order to meet legal requirements and to qualify as a participant in the Student Election Worker Program I must:***

- be at least 16 years of age on Election Day;
- be a United States citizen; resident of Johnson County, KS;
- provide a clear copy and current copy of my Social Security Card and Driver's License (*copy for the payroll department is required before training and assignment*);
- never have been convicted of a crime that would affect my ability to be an Election Worker;
- cannot be related to anyone on the ballot in the precinct where appointed;
- collect a parent/guardian permission signature;
- provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or administrator pursuant to K.S.A. 25-2804;
- complete mandatory training;
- provide my own transportation to and from the polling place;
- report to my assigned polling place 1 hour prior to opening and remain at the polling place after the 7 PM closing;
- commit to the entire day, *NO EXCEPTIONS*.
